to end poverty for asylum seekers!



2007 marks the 10th anniversary of our federal government denying thousands of asylum seekers the right to work, income and health care. By doing so they force asylum seeker families into a life of destitution, hunger, homelessness, ill health and despair.

ON FRIDAY NIGHT THE 18TH OF MAY 2007 we are seeking as many people as possible to join the Asylum Seeker Resource Centre (ASRC) in sleeping outside the Department of Immigration and Citizenship for the night to raise public awareness about the desperate plight of asylum seekers and to pressure our government to end it's inhumane policies.

FIND A SPONSOR

We also ask you to GET PEOPLE TO SPONSOR YOU to sleepout for the night (see back of flyer) to help raise urgently needed funds for the ASRC to provide food, medicines and aid to destitute people seeking asylum.

When: Friday 18th of May 2007 from 6pm onwards

Where: 2 Lonsdale Street, City (50 metres from Parliament Train Station)

Bring: Sleeping bag, warm clothing, wet weather gear if raining, food (the ASRC will also be selling food cheaply at the sleepout to help raise funds for our aid work).
